Age of Admittance to Grades K-1

A child shall be eligible for enrollment in kindergarten or first grade, at the beginning of the school year or at a later time in the same year, if the child has his/her fifth or sixth birthday, respectively, on or before September 1. At the beginning of each school year, the Superintendent or designee shall enroll any eligible child who will have his/her fifth or sixth birthday on or before September 1 of that year into kindergarten or first grade, as applicable.

Any child who will have his/her fifth birthday prior to September $\frac{1}{2}$ *through December 2 of the school year* for the applicable school year shall be offered a transitional kindergarten *(TK)* program in accordance with law and Board policy.

On a case-by-case basis, a child who reaches age five after September 1 for the applicable will turn five years old in a given school year may be admitted to will turn five years old in a given kindergarten or TK at any time during the that school year with the approval of the child's parent/guardian, provided that:

- 1. The Superintendent or designee *The Governing Board* determines that the admittance is in the best interests of the child.
- 2. The parent/guardian is given information regarding the advantages and disadvantages and any other explanatory information about the effect of this early admittance.
- 3. The Board of Trustees approves the admittance.

In determining whether a child may be granted early entry to kindergarten, Tthe Superintendent or designee may also consider the shall make a recommendation to the Board regarding whether a child should be granted early entry to kindergarten. In doing so, the Superintendent or designee shall consider various factors including the availability of classroom space and any negotiated maximum class size.

Documentation of Age/Grade

Prior to the admission of a child to kindergarten or first grade, the parent/guardian shall present proof of the child's age.

Evidence of the child's age may include:

- 1. A certified copy of a birth certificate or a statement by the local registrar or county recorder certifying the date of birth
- 2. A duly attested baptism certificate
- 3. Passport
- 4. When none of the above documents is obtainable, an affidavit of the parent/guardian
- 5. Other means prescribed by the Board

When none of the foregoing is obtainable, an affidavit from the parent/guardian may be accepted until such time as the legal forms of evidence are obtainable or the parent/guardian demonstrates that the legal evidences are not obtainable. When submitting an affidavit, each case will be reviewed in 30 days to verify receipt of legal evidence of age for each child.

ADMISSION

A student enrolling in a district school at any other grade level shall present records from his/her previous school district documenting his/her age and current grade level.
