

- Students without access to instructional materials
- Facilities do not meet the "good repair" standard

Priority 2 Implementation of Academic Standards

- In areas of ELA, Math, ELD, NGSS, and History/SS
 - Professional Development
 - Alignment of Instructional Materials
 - Instructional support for Teachers
- Implementation of Other Academic Standards
 - PE, CTE, VPA, Health Education, World Language
- Support for teachers and Administrators
 - Identifying PD for groups and individual teachers and support for teachers on standards they have not mastered



Priority 3 Parent Engagement
