**WEEK OF THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR**

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**WHEREAS**, leadership matters for California's public education system and the more than 6 million students it serves; and

**WHEREAS**, school administrators are passionate, lifelong learners who believe in the value of quality public education; and

**WHEREAS**, the title "school administrator" is a broad term used to define many educational leadership positions, including superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, special education and adult education leaders, curriculum and assessment leaders, school business officials, classified educational leaders, and other school district employees who are considered administrators; and

**WHEREAS**, providing quality service for student success is paramount to the profession; and

**WHEREAS**, most school administrators began their careers as teachers, with the average administrator serving in public education for more than a decade, and most of California's superintendents having served in education for more than 20 years, bringing valuable experience to their work effectively and efficiently leading public education and improving student achievement; and

**WHEREAS**, public schools operate with lean management systems, employing fewer managers and supervisors than most public and private sector industries, including transportation, food service, manufacturing, utilities, construction, publishing, and public administration; and

**WHEREAS**, research shows that great principals lead great schools, and great superintendents and assistant superintendents lead great districts, supported by extensive administrative networks throughout the county and state; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California has declared the second full week of October, October 13-19, 2024, as the "Week of the School Administrator" as stated in Education Code 44015.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the future of California's public education system depends upon the quality of its leadership;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Silver Valley Unified School District Board of Trustees that all school leaders be commended for the contributions they make to successful student achievement.
