 - Multi-Year Projection





2021-22 Budget Assumptions

- Based on May Revise
 - Some changes likely when budget is finalized
- In person, with Virtual option
- ADA Increase of 60
- Continued investment in RTI/Social Emotional (SEL)/Class size
 - 13 additional FTE
 - Certificated: 7 teachers (5 Rtl)
 - Classified: 4 Categorical Aides; 2 Custodians; Cat. Aide hours
 - Admin: Assistant Principal; Psychologist

- Enrollment uncertainty
 - Down over 180 students at end of year
- Special Ed, Transportation, CNS contributions
- Covid-19 Expenses
 - O Distance Learning?
 - o PPE
 - Sanitation/Supplies
